Data Update

There are currently 18 people participating in the Road Watch Project.

A total of 38 observations have been entered using the mapping tool. Sightings include:

Big horn sheep	15
Cougar	1
Wolf	1
Grizzly bear	1
Elk	2
Mule deer	12
White-tailed deer	4
Deer	1
Unknown	1

The locations are displayed on the map below. Each point represents one event and does not indicate group size.
