### Monitoring Wildlife Update

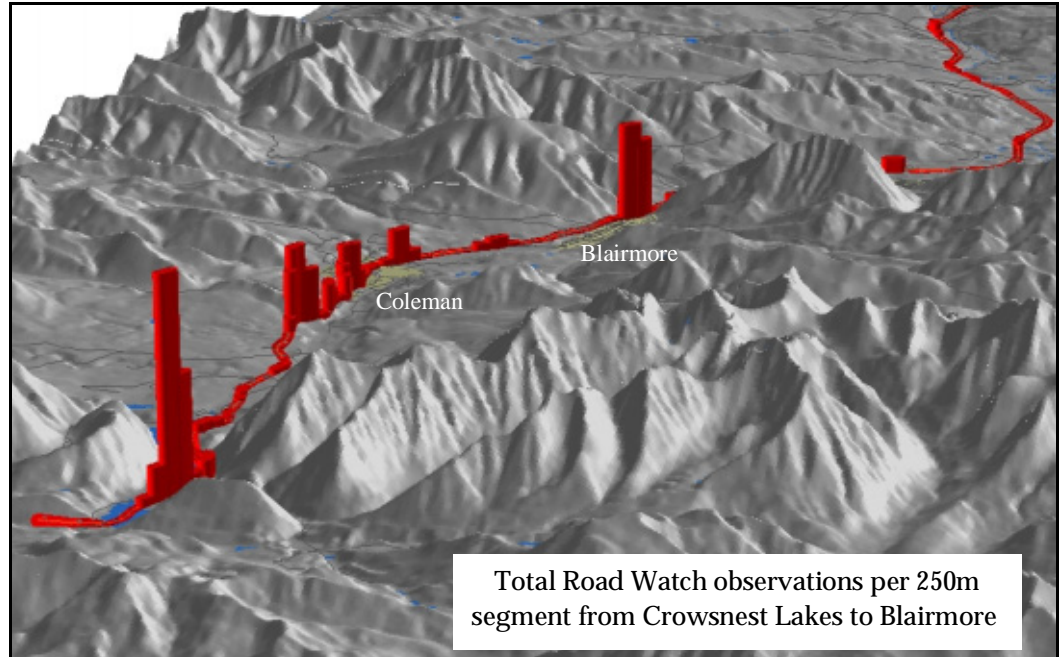
There are currently **55** people participating in the Road Watch Project.

A total of **622** observations have been entered using the mapping tool. Sightings include:

Big horn sheep	112
Cougar	4
Wolf	3
Grizzly bear	3
Black Bear	9
Elk	35
Mule deer	268
White-tailed deer	70
Deer	76
Moose	31
Coyote	11
